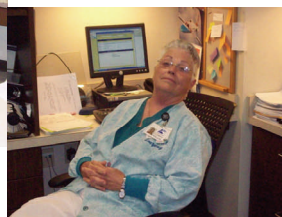

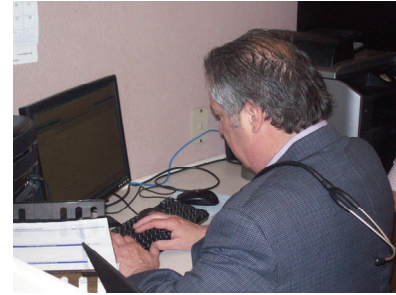

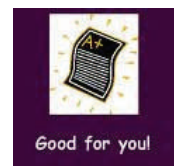
Stuart Butler, Brian Jones, Charles Coleman and Scott Wells have all passed the HAM Radio test.
